Students should excel in academics, community service activities and school-related activities. In addition, students must submit an essay.

This scholarship may be for your student if...

- They are active in their school and community.
- They have at least a 3.0 GPA and are a graduating senior or currently attending a college or university.
- You are a current paid Cincinnati CPCU Society Chapter member.
- Application is received electronically by noon on **April 28, 2023**.

The scholarship may be used for tuition, room and board, or books.

Winner will only be able to receive 1 scholarship if eligible for both "Cincinnati CPCU Society Scholarship" and "Cincinnati CPCU Society Gamma Iota Sigma Student Scholarship."
