Guidelines for Cincinnati CPCU Society Chapter Scholarship

As a part of its mission to provide value to chapter membership, the Cincinnati CPCU Society Chapter provides educational financial assistance in the form of scholarships to graduating high school and college students (including spouses) of current chapter members. Stepchildren are also eligible.

The Cincinnati CPCU Society Chapter reaches out to a new generation of potential insurance professionals by encouraging high school and college students to look at the role insurance plays in serving our society and prompting interest in insurance careers.

To inspire the future participation of young people in the insurance service industry, a scholarship fund has been established to recognize high school and/or college students who have set an example for their peers by working to support activity in community service and school-related activities.

Each Spring, monetary scholarships are awarded in amounts based on availability of funds to student(s) who excel in academics and are involved in their communities.

The recipients will be selected from candidates who submit the prescribed information electronically by the deadline. Winners will be notified by email.

The scholarship committee of the Cincinnati CPCU Society Chapter will review the applications and identify scholarship recipients each Spring.

We will award up to five \$1,000 scholarships.

The scholarship may be used for tuition, room and board, or books.
